tie

A tie is a curved line that connects two or more notes of the same pitch. Ties connect one note value to another.

slur

A slur is a curved line drawn over or under a series of notes, indicating that those notes should be played legato.

whole note

A whole note is equal to 4 beats in 4/4 time.

dotted half note

A dotted half note is equal to 3 beats in 4/4 time.

quarter note

A quarter note is equal to 1 beat in 4/4 time.

eighth note

An eighth note is equal to 1/2 of a beat in 4/4 time.

alto clef

This symbol is called an alto clef (also known as a C clef or viola clef).

brace

The brace is used to connect two or more different staves in a musical score into a system.

This symbol cancels previous signs such as sharps and flats.

ledger lines

Ledger lines are little lines that go above or below the staff. Ledger lines are used to show notes that go beyond the staff.

A fermata is a symbol placed over a note or rest. It tells you to hold it longer than its normal duration.
